

# Types of Navigation

## Top-level (Global) Navigation

- This same set of navigation items is displayed on every page
- May expand to 3 levels (see details below)
- The items in the navigation inform the way content is populated on the site
- These items are set up by WIN staff
- Items may be changed or updated periodically

### Navigation Level 1

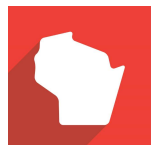
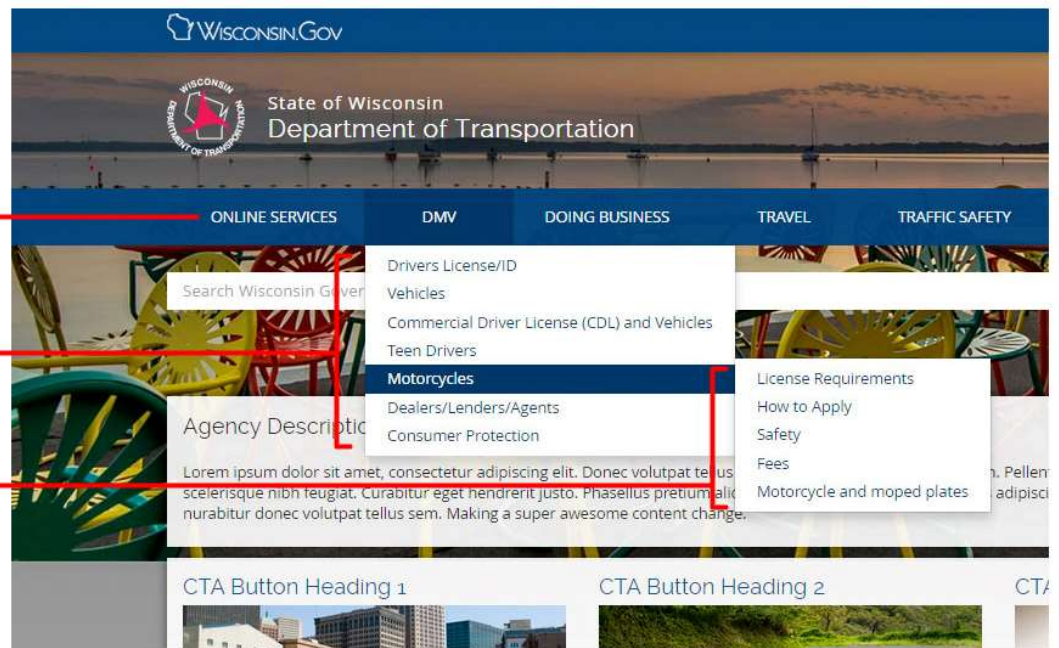
- 7 total links; 15 characters max
- When clicked in the header menu, they will display “fly-outs” for Level 2 items
- Level 1 items have no “landing page”

### Navigation Level 2

- 30 characters max
- When clicked in the header menu, they will display “fly-outs” for Level 3 items if present. If not, the associated “landing page” for the Level 2 item opens.

### Navigation Level 3

- 30 characters max
- When clicked they will open the associated “landing page” for the Level 3 item



## In-page (Local) Navigation

- Maintained in the left or right sidebar
- This navigation is optional; may be used on some pages, and not on others, as needed
- Useful for longer-length pages with multiple headings
- Provides links to the major headings
- May alternatively provide links to other pages, documents, etc.
- Authors can use this type of navigation for content that isn't included in the top-level (global) navigation
- These items can be set up and maintained by agency authors
